FORESTA - Mosquito and ticks repellent

1. Foresta

Long acting mosquito and ticks repellent Designed for use by people who require effective protection against mosquitoes and ticks in harsh outdoor conditions. High efficiency of the preparation was achieved by using of three active ingredients: DEET 30 %, IR 3535® 20 % and Geraniol 0,1 %.

Light consistency allows for very comfortable use and release of active substances at the same time

2. How to use Foresta?

Apply a thin layer with atomizer on dry, clean, undamaged skin, avoiding mucous membranes of the eyes and natural openings of the body. In a case of face and neck application, apply indirectly - spray your hand and then gently spread.

Application: children from 12 years of age - once a day, adults - 2 times a day

3. Contraindications to use Foresta

Do not use in people who have experienced symptoms of allergy or hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients. Do not use in children under 12 years of age. Do not use on children's hands. Do not use the preparation on damaged, irritated or inflamed skin with itching.

4. Recommendations and precautions while using Foresta

For external use only. Store in a dry and dark place, out of reach of children, at room temperature. Do not use after the expiry date stated on the package.

Attention! Foresta ingredients can damage clothing and plastic elements - attention should be paid when applying the preparation.

5. What DEET, IR3535® and Graniol are?

DEET (N, N-Diethylmethanolamide) is a most commonly used insect repellent, eg. for mosquitoes, flies, horse flies, ticks or tsetse flies. It was developed by the US Army chemists, after the experience gained in combat in moist tropical forests during World War II. The first military use took place in 1946, and civilian in 1957.

DEET protection time on skin or clothing is between 2 and 12 hours, depending on the concentration of this ingredient in the preparation. The US Government Agency for Disease Control and Prevention, CDC, recommends DEET concentrations range from 20-50% to effectively prevent the transmission of various pathogens spread by biting insects. (Concentration above that range does not improve the preparation efficacy).

IR3535® (ang. Insect Repellent 3535; N-n-butyl-N-acetyl-propionic acid ethyl ester; repellent for mosquito, ticks, horse and moth flies; It can potentially also deter lice, bees and wasps. Used in USA since 1999. Registered as an EPA biopesticide, which means that it can be seen as a product of natural origin, although it is made of synthetic substances structurally based on naturally occurring amino acids (B-alanine). It exhibits lower toxicity than other active ingredients.

Geraniol - (trans-3,7-dimethylkalo-2,6-dien-1-ol) -cyclic monoterpene alcohol, ingredient characterised by a sweet floral scent with a hint of citrus fruit. A fully natural oil effectively repels insects. According to the American study, conducted by the University of Florida, it reduces chance of bites by ticks, fleas and mosquitoes by 90-99%.

6. Why have we combined three active ingredients?

The combination of three mosquito and tick repelling ingredients represents a higher efficiency comparing to products containing only one active ingredient.

Product form: Liquid

Use:

Liquid repelling mosquitoes and ticks, designed to use directly on skin. Up to 4 hour activity.

Apply a thin layer with atomizer on dry, clean, undamaged skin, avoiding mucous membranes of the eyes and the natural openings of the body. In a case of face and neck application, apply indirectly - spray your hand and then gently spread.

Do not use in people who have experienced symptoms of allergy or hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients. Do not use in children under 12 years of age. Do not use on children's hands
